- MATH 1113 UNIV 1110: Introduction to Pre-Calculus
A review of the algebra concepts essential to student success in MATH 1113. Topics include factoring, solving equations and inequalities, rational, radical, exponential and logarithmic functions, and graphing. (3 hours elective degree credit)

- MATH 1101 UNIV 1108: Introduction to Data Analysis
An introduction to the concepts of analyzing and describing data using statistics, mathematical models, and other quantitative tools. Emphasis is placed on conducting the analysis and interpreting the results. (3 hours elective degree credit)
