Congratulations on your acceptance to Freshman College Summer Experience (FCSE)! We welcome you to the University of Georgia and are excited about your arrival in June. University Housing is a proud and long-standing partner of the Division of Academic Enhancement for FCSE. Our mission is to provide comfortable, affordable, and secure on-campus housing options in residential communities where the academic success and personal growth of residents are encouraged and supported. Although FCSE was intended to be located in Oglethorpe House, we are anticipating recent adjustments to the schedule of a maintenance project at Oglethorpe House to cause significant disruptions and inconveniences for summer occupants. Therefore, to create the most conducive conditions for the success of FCSE participants, the program will move to another building for the summer. University Housing, in collaboration with the Division of Academic Enhancement, has selected Building 1516 as the alternate location. We regret this inconvenient, yet necessary change.

In Building 1516, participants will experience the FCSE cohort design at the reduced Oglethorpe House rate. On Tuesday, August 1, University Housing will provide assistance to move students' belongings into their Oglethorpe House fall assignment for academic year 2017-2018 (at no additional charge).
