About the Program

The mission of the ALL Georgia Program is twofold: to support all rural students at the University of Georgia with a network of resources and some common experiences and to provide unique programs and opportunities to a cohort of specially selected ALL Georgia Scholars. The network of resources for all rural students includes academic enrichment, mentoring, leadership development, and community engagement programming. The ALL Georgia Program represents a partnership among the Office of Instruction (primarily Division of Academic Enhancement, Office of Undergraduate Admissions, Office of Student Financial Aid, and Academic Advising Services), Division of Student Affairs, Public Service and Outreach, the Graduate School, and University Libraries.

The name ALL Georgia unites two ideas: 1) the creation of a new rural access and success agenda for bringing the state together via the missions of its flagship institution of higher education and 2) a broad-based collaboration at the University that unites us all around the idea of one University for all.

- To deliver targeted programming and support for these students.
- To foster a more inclusive and diverse campus.
- To blend curricular and co-curricular programming and services to empower these students to find their sense of community at UGA and connect their college experience to their home communities and beyond.
